

GALINA LANSKAIA, VIOLONIST

A Musical Odyssey Through Time and Cultures

Born near Moscow, Galina Lanskaia discovered her passion for the violin at a very young age. Her musical journey led her to study at prestigious institutions, including the Mozarteum University in Salzburg, where she graduated with a Bachelor of Arts degree in 2020. During this time, she also worked as a substitute violinist with the Salzburg Philharmonic Orchestra and performed chamber music concerts from 2016 to 2017.

Over the years, Galina has had the opportunity to perform on various international stages. From 2018 to 2020, she was a violinist with the Bad Reichenhaller Philharmoniker orchestra in Germany. In 2022, she joined the Nouvel Europe Orchestra and taught violin at the Académie Inter Musicale in Paris from 2023 to 2024. In 2024, she also conducted a workshop and gave a concert at Bangalore School of Music and Fine Arts in India.

Galina has engaged in diverse collaborations with artists from different backgrounds. In 2024, she collaborated with Parovoz on the recording of an album and took part in Marjane Satrapi's film *Paradis Paris*. In 2022, she performed with Yousoupha at the Scène Nationale and appeared on a television programme with Sting on France 2.

Passionate about passing on her knowledge, Galina has participated in masterclasses around the world, including sessions with Alexander Markov in 2024 and Yair Kless in 2023.

Her talent has been widely recognised through numerous awards, including the European Virtuoso Music Awards in 2025 and the Vermeil Medal from the Arts-Sciences-Lettres Society in 2023.

Her performance highlights include cycles of Beethoven sonatas at the Théâtre de Bligny in 2023. She has also made solo appearances with symphony orchestras, such as at the Narva Music Forum Festival in 2022 with the Narva City Symphony Orchestra and in 2018 with the Bad Reichenhaller Philharmoniker.
